Naturewatch Campaign to Stop Puppy Farms

- A mandatory local authority licence required after two litters per year, not the current four litters.
- A uniform code of practice for all inspections of breeding premises.
- All advertising media to have an information panel on any pages advertising puppies for sale.
- All adverts in all media to include the breeder licence number in order to identify the breeder and his location.
- General public education on what to look for when buying a puppy.
- Mandatory microchipping for each puppy, together with breeder details, pedigree details, health screening checks.
